
The Quail & Manna Sequence

- 14th Day at Evening (Sabbath) They encamped in Elim by the waters. Exodus 15:27
- They arrive in the wilderness of Sin on the 15th day of the second month (2nd New Moon). *Exodus* 16

And they came to **Elim**, where were twelve wells of water, and threescore and ten palm trees: and they encamped there by the waters. **Exodus 15:27**

And the whole congregation of the children of Israel murmured against Moses and Aaron in the wilderness: And the children of Israel said unto them, would to Yah we had died by the hand of Yah in the land of Egypt, when we sat by flesh pots, and we did eat bread to the full; for ye have brought us forth into this wilderness, to kill this whole congregation with hunger. **Exodus 16:2,3**

The Cloud Movement



And they took there journey from Elim, and all the congregation of the children of Israel came unto the wilderness of Sin, which is between Elim and Sinai, on the **fifteenth day of the second month** after departing out of Egypt. **Exodus 16:1**

And it came to pass, as Aaron spake unto the whole congregation of the children of Israel, that they looked toward the wilderness, and, behold, the glory of Yah appeared in the cloud. Exodus 16:10

And Yah spake unto Moses saying, I have heard the murmurings of the children of Israel: speak unto them, saying, At **even** ye shall eat flesh, and in the morning ye shall be filled with bread: and ye shall know that I am Yah your God. **Exodus 16:11,12**

And it came to pass, that at even the quails came up, and covered the camp and in the morning the dew lay round about the host. *Exodus* 16:13


> Wilderness Elam





The scripture sets the date of the arrival of Israel in the wilderness of Sin in Exodus 16:1. We must understand that the arrival of the Israelites was in the second month on the fifteenth day of the month, and not as if they had already arrived. In chapter 16:2-10 describes a conversation that took place on the sabbath with Moses, Aaron, Ahiyah, and the Israelites. It describes what was presently going on, and what would transpire when they would arrive in the Wilderness of Sin on the fifteenth day of the second month. You will see that Exodus 16:10 reveals they were still in Elim, as they looked toward the wilderness and sees

the glory of Yah in the cloud. It was at this point after the sabbath on the 14th day, they took their journey to arrive in the Wilderness of Sin on the 15th day at evening. They were at the border of Elim and could easily see the next destination. Israel's six day work cycle begins, and the sabbath count begins. Quail was all around the camp, and it took the whole congregation of Israel two days to gather the quail.

Day 1 Work Day Starts

Conjunction - A conjunction last a moment, and light begins to gradually increase again after the conjunction way before you can see it from earth. About a day from the time of the conjunction, the Moon would be visible with the naked eye at a 2% illumination, and it is the 1st day of the new month. The sabbath count begins on this day and secular work can begin.


The flood waters receded, leaving behind a layer of rich black soil. This fertile soil was then plowed, seeded and began growing.

The fully grown crop had to be cut and harvested before the Nile flooded again.

While the earth remained, seed-time and harvest, cold and heat, and summer and winter, and day and night shall not cease. Genesis 8: 22


The Israelite sustainability was dependent upon strict agricultural practices, and obedience to His commandments. They were taught that obedience would bring them a rich supply of grace, and they would be able to distinguish between the sacred and common. Disobedience always brings evil. If the Israelites chose to manage the land in their own supposed wisdom, they would notice no intervention by Yah to counteract their evils. Yah taught His people what they must do to be a prosperous and independent nation, and the land would yield its increase hundredfold. Now, because the Israelites began to come away from the practices set forth by Yah, and adopted heathen agricultural practices, we are reaping what we sow. Disease of many forms upon our lands, crop failures, and much more. Israelite seasons are to be kept synchronized by how Yah has outlined it to be, that it may bring praise and glory to His name.



Abib

This month shall be unto you the beginning of months; it shall be the first month of the year to you (**Exodus 12:2**). And Moses said unto the people, Remember this day, in which ye came out from Egypt, out of the house of bondage; for by the strength of hand Yah brought you out from this place: there shall no leavened bread be eaten (**Exodus 13:3,4**). This day came ye out in the month **Abib** The word of Abib in Hebrew means, budding/sprouting. Before the seventh plaque of hail fell upon the Egyptian crops, this is what Moses saw, "the barley was in the ear, and the flax was **bolled**, and wheat and rye was not grown up (**Exodus 9: 31,32**). Flax was in **bolled** stage. **Bolled** in Hebrew is **gabol** , which means **the calix of flowers.** If you look at these crop stages, you will notice that there is no way that Passover connects to a Spring season. Neither of these crops would be in this young stage at the beginning of spring, The crops would have been already in the ripening stage near to harvesting.


The Migration of Egypt's Quail



There was no Quail available to the Israelites after 15th day of the third month of the Hebrew Year, which would have placed this event during Egypt's winter season. For Yah allowed the Israelites a whole month to consume as much as their lust desired during this winter season. If the feast days started in spring of March/April as many believe, then we must understand that Quail would have never been in the African region with such abundance to feed Israel. It was for this reason why Yah just allowed them one month of Quail, in keeping with His synchronized ecosystem. As proved before, another sign that Yah has appointed the beginning of the month in winter.

How long shall I expect the children of men to work salvation for my arm by their righteousness? Then the Holy One, blessed be he, will reveal his great arm in the world, " and show it to the gentiles: it shall be as long as the world and as broad as the world," and the glory of its splendor shall be like the brilliant light of the noonday sun at the Summer Solstice. At once Israel shall be save from among the gentiles and the Messiah shall appear to them and bring them up to Jerusalem with great joy. Moreover, the kingdom of Israel, gathered from the four quarters of the world, shall eat with the Messiah, and the gentiles shall eat with them, as it is written. 3 Enoch Ch. 48A: 8-10 (Read also Revelation 7:9,17)
